What happens next

EasyAccessPDF auto-fix rebuilds the tag structure (headings, lists, tables, figures with alt-text candidates), sets the document language and title, then re-validates with veraPDF. A human review checklist flags the items automation cannot judge - alt-text quality and reading context.

After Auto-Fix - Re-validation

Same document after automated tagging and validation

Grade B

4 review items

Fully tagged. 4 items remain for human review.

- Structure tree (StructTreeRoot) built: 214 elements tagged
- Document language set to en-US
- DisplayDocTitle enabled; XMP title synchronized
- Heading hierarchy H1-H3 mapped from layout analysis
- 3 data tables annotated with header rows and scope
- 14 images given alt-text candidates for review

Human review checklist (included with every fix)

- Confirm alt-text describes each image purpose, not just its appearance
 - Check reading order of the two-column layout on pages 7-9
 - Verify table headers match the visual grouping on page 12
 - Confirm decorative images are marked as artifacts
